Waverley Night Netball Association Inc. invites teams and clubs to compete in the 2025 Autumn Night Competitions.

The following details include major rules for the 2025 Autumn Competitions organised by the Waverley Night Netball Association Inc. When you enter the Competition, you accept to play by all Rules of the Association. A full copy of the rules is published in your fixture books on the website and available on request from the Association.

COMPETITIONS AVAILABLE:

MONDAY

Female Open Age Indoor Competition:

- Monday: earliest game 6.45pm, latest game 9.15pm start
- Umpires: First named team must supply an umpire
- Entry Fee: \$90.00 per team Court Fee **\$63.00** per team per game

TUESDAY

Female Premier League Open Age Competition:

- Matches: Will be 4 x 15 minute with no injury time allowed
- Earliest game 6.15pm, latest game 9:35pm start
- Umpires: Supplied
- Entry Fee: \$90.00 per team Court Fee **\$95.00** per team per game

WEDNESDAY

Female Premier League 17 & Under Competition:

- Matches: Will be 4 x 15 minute, quarters with no injury time allowed. All matches played at 5.50pm or 7.00pm (Outdoors). Section 1 indoors, Section 2-5 Outdoors.
- Umpires: Supplied
- Entry Fee: \$90.00 per team Indoor Court Fee **\$95.00** per team per game Outdoor Court Fee **\$75.00** per team per game

Female Open Age Indoor Competition:

- Matches: earliest game 7.00pm, latest game 9.15pm start
- Umpires: First named team must supply an umpire or apply for an umpire to the association
- Entry Fee: \$90.00 per team Court Fee **\$63.00** per team per game

THURSDAY

Female 13 & Under Competition:

(Males under 13 years of age as at the first day of competition (30/01/2025) may participate)

- Matches: 5.15pm, 6.00pm or 6:45pm
- Umpires: First named team must supply an umpire or apply for an umpire to the association
- Entry Fee: \$90.00 per team
 Court Fee \$60.00 per team per game

Female 15 & Under Competition:

(Males less than 13 years of age as at the first day of competition (30/01/2025) may participate)

- Match Times: 6.45pm, 7.30pm, 8.15pm or 9.00pm
- Umpires: First named team must supply an umpire or apply for an umpire to the association
- Entry Fee: \$90.00 per team
 Court Fee \$60.00 per team per game

Match times are a guide only; it will depend on the number of teams entered into the competition.

No Admittance Fee

is charged to enter the Waverley Netball Centre on competition nights.

TO ENTER:

- All teams must enter ONLINE. Information on how to complete this will be available on the website when entries open. www.waverleynetball.com.au
- The entry fee is non-refundable once teams are accepted into the competition.
- Entries for all teams for the 2025 Autumn Competitions must be entered online by <u>2nd</u>
 <u>December 2024 at 5.00pm</u> with the entry fee of \$90.00 per team. Entry is not complete
 unless entry fee is paid.
- An Acceptance Letter notifying you of your Teams acceptance or non-acceptance will be emailed from the Office no later than 9th December 2024.
- Every player must hold a Netball Victoria Membership and Waverley Night NA Membership
 before taking the court to play, because you are entering to play with a Netball Victoria
 Affiliated Association All players, coaches and umpires in Victoria are required to pay an
 annual membership fee.
 - Information on how to purchase will come with the Acceptance letter.
- Any team and /or player may play Netball at this Centre on each night; however, a player
 may only play for ONE team in any one <u>competition</u>. Please note the different competitions
 on page 2, which means players, can play more than one game on a night, but in different
 competitions.

UMPIRES, COACHES, TEAM MANAGERS, AND OTHER VOLUNTEERS/ OFFICIALS

PHOTO CONSENT POLICY:

Photography and video footage will only be permitted by WNNA and its teams or clubs for three purposes:

- 1. Player/Umpire training and development
- 2. Association/Club promotion and publicity
- 3. For personal use by the Participant and/or family only

Association Photographer

From time-to-time, WNNA will engage a photographer/videographer to take footage for the *purpose of selling images* to participants or interested persons. Prior consent from teams or individuals, including umpires will be obtained for this purpose. Any non-consent will be clearly articulated to the engaged photographer/videographer so that images of non-consenting Teams or individuals are not obtained nor made available for purchase.

Outdoor Venues

The Waverley Netball Centre venues is a public open space. Neither Netball Victoria nor an Association can stop anyone taking photographs or video images in this instance. Someone unknown to the Association who arrives at the venue and starts filming can be asked for what purpose they are filming. If the answer is satisfactory, they can be requested, but not forced, to register as per the recommended guidelines below. If the answer is not satisfactory and the person continues to behave in a 'suspicious' manner, then the Police may be called.

Indoor Venues

Indoor venues such as Waverley Netball Centre may have particular photography/video restrictions or guidelines in place which must be followed. WNC asks photographers being engaged by club/teams to register at reception prior.

Condition Of Entry

The WNNA may wish to record images of participants during WNNA competitions for promotional and training/development purposes. These images may be used in mediums including publications and promotional material, and broadcast, print and electronic media.

WNNA agrees not to use any photo in a manner that may be deemed adverse or defamatory to the person(s) involved and it will not use the photo for any commercial gain. The photos will remain the property of the WNNA and any personal details regarding this photo will be kept confidential and will not be used for any purpose other than related to this photo.

During this competition parents and family of players may wish to record images of their family members participating for personal use only. Where possible such requests will be authorised and subject to certain conditions, noting that on public land this is not enforceable.

It is a condition of entry into the WNNA competition that participants may be subject to photography/filming as described above and that consent is provided for this purpose**.

As the Club / Team Contact entering the team into the competition, you advise that all team members and parents/guardians (if under 18) are aware of the above conditions and agree to comply.

** Under special circumstances an exemption may be granted – the team/individual needs to state, in writing, the reason an exemption is being sought to the Centre Manager.

BASIC COMPETITION INFORMATION:

FIXTURES:

Fixtures will be available online the day after fixture pick up. Please make sure you read the online fixtures in conjunction with the information in the Fixture Book for all Association Rules and regulations.

UNIFORMS:

All Clubs/Teams are required to nominate their playing uniform in the Club/Team Entry Form, which must then be approved by the Competition. All players must wear the Club/Team's approved playing uniform throughout the season.

Each Team must wear regulation playing bibs. **Sponsorship on regulation playing initials** (bibs) are reserved for the Competition sponsor - no other sponsorship is allowed on bibs without prior permission.

WALKOVERS:

If, a Team forfeits prior to the game clock starting at the scheduled time, the game shall be awarded to the non-offending team (4 points, score 10-0 or 15-0 for a premier game).

A maximum of 12 nominated players of the non-offending Team shall be credited a game for qualification purposes. Players of the offending Team shall not be credited a game.

A forfeit fine will be imposed which must be paid before the next fixtured Game for the offending team <u>as</u> per the by-laws. Failure to notify the office of a walkover will attract an additional 4-point penalty.

CLEARANCES:

Players require clearance <u>ONLY</u> if they commence playing a competition with the one team and desire to transfer to another team on <u>that same night</u>, in the <u>same competition during that season</u>. Clearances will not be granted after <u>Round 10</u>. Any player, whose name was not on the original team entry form and desires to drop more than two Grades/Divisions, must make written application to the Management Committee before playing with the new team.

FINALS:

All players in final matches must have played in at least three matches with the team in which they will be playing in the final series. Players playing in Premier League competitions must have played in at least five matches with the team in which they will be playing in the final series.

KIOSK:

Waverley Night Netball Association Inc supply and manage the full Kiosk which operates with 47 chairs and tables indoors servery area plus an outside sales area. You can enjoy a light meal, barista made coffee, cold drinks, ice creams etc. By purchasing from the kiosk, you are supporting the Netball Association.

UMPIRES:

Teams competing in competitions, other than Premier League are required to supply an umpire. The Team umpire should have a badge or at a minimum completed a Foundation (formerly Level 1) Umpires course and Rules of Netball Exam. The team umpire will be required to umpire when the team is first named in the fixture, as rostered per the bottom of the fixture (approx. half the games in the season). 13/U, 15/U and 17/U may be required to umpire at the same time as they play or before or after they play. Open Indoor & Outdoor team umpires are required to umpire before or after your match. If your team has trouble finding a Team Umpire, please request an umpire from the association. Cost is \$28.00 per game required. A link to register will be provided with your acceptance letter.

The Association supplies a Panel Umpire for every match. All Team Umpires are required to complete an umpire's registration sheet on the first occasion they umpire. Failure for a team umpire to appear at rostered time and game may results in the loss of 4 points for the team and a fine of \$40.00. Premier League Umpires: It is hoped that we can continue to supply two Badged Umpires to each Open Age and 17/U Premier League match during the season.

FIRST AID:

Currently we have First Aid available every night for competition and we hope this continues in 2025. First Aid is located down the passageway from reception, opposite the display cabinet.

First Aid can also be obtained from reception, if a dedicated volunteer is not on duty.

The Committee looks forward to receiving your team's entry for the 2025 Autumn season.
